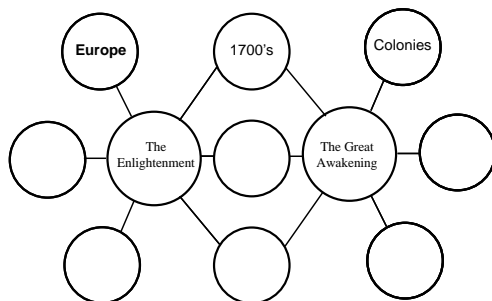
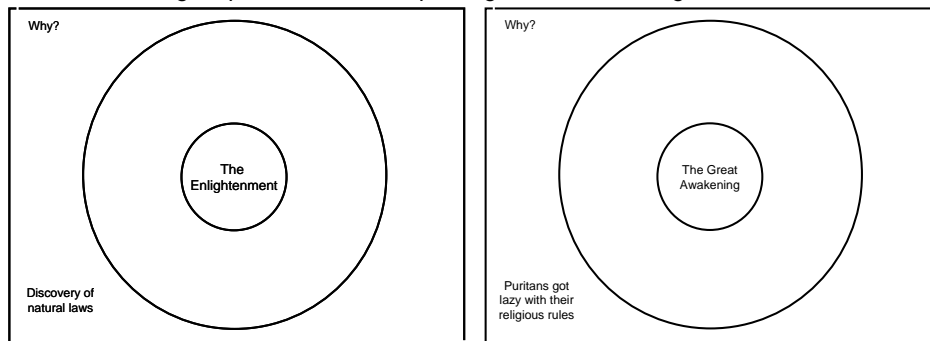
Make one double bubble map comparing and contrasting the two movements. Facts in the middle are things they have in common, things that are different go on the outside.
