Missouri Compromise Notes

Sectionalism = disagreements between the different regions In 1819 the regions were:

North (11 states)	VS.	South (11 states)
Manufacturing		Agriculture/Farming
Anti-slavery		Pro-slavery

In 1820 Missouri applies to become a state (as a slave state) approval would give slave states more votes in the Senate

Compromise:

- 1. Missouri could enter the Union as a slave state
- 2. Maine would join as a free state (to keep #'s equal)
- 3. Slavery would be prohibited (banned) in any new territories or states formed north of the 36°30' latitude

Compromise helped, but North and South still had strong disagreements.
